The Election Center has developed a new State Registered Election Official (REO) program that operates as a joint effort between individual states and The Election Center. This is an intense and challenging certification program, specifically tailored to teach election requirements and procedures of individual states. All courses are taught by tenured, nationally accredited CERA election administrators.

Offered at the State level, the State Registered Election Official (REO) training program is an affordable option for local election administrators and their staff. The uniqueness of the program also provides state election organizations an opportunity to generate revenue from the course offerings within their own state. Courses can be completed in a number of variations - two course in one day; four courses in two days; or all eight courses in four days your choice.

States currently participating in the REO program include the states of California, Delaware and Virginia.
