(b) No person shall serve as an inspector of a precinct board at the election unless instruction has been received in accordance with this election.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Notify the Registrar of Voters office immediately at (714) 954-1901 if you are unable to work on Election Day.
- · It's important that you complete training as instructed to work Election Day.
- All poll workers must be at their assigned poll site by 6:00 a.m. on Election Day.
- Please make contact with your board members as soon as possible to plan Early Set Up (where available) and discuss Election Day.
- Due to confidentiality reasons, contact information of students is not listed. You
 can contact your student poll worker(s) by calling (866) 680-2417. You will be
 prompted to enter the student's Poll Worker ID listed above. Upon confirming the information entered you will be connected directly to the student's phone.
- As a poll worker, you are representing the Registrar of Voters at the poll sites. The facility where you are volunteering has also volunteered their services. Please adhere to any rules and/or policies they request. Be respectful of the facilities property.
- · Recruitment is still in progress! Please visit ocvote.com/pass for updates.
- Before the polls open, all poll workers must take the Inspector/Poll Worker
 Oath and sign the Payroll Form found in the Combined Roster Index. Failure
 to comply with these instructions will result in the delay of or non-receipt of compensation for working Election Day.

FEDERAL AND STATE REQUIREMENTS

MINORITY LANGUAGE ASSISTANCE: As required by the Federal Voting Rights Act Section 203, language materials are available in Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese and Korean upon request.

FAILURE TO SERVE: Any voter, who has accepted appointment as a precinct officer and without being excused by the Registrar, knowingly fails to serve, is subject to a \$100 fine under the provisions of the Elections Code

PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF ELECTION LAWS: Any person who in any manner interferes with officers holding an election or conducting a canvass, or interferes with voters who are lawfully exercising their voting rights at an election, and prevents the election or canvass from being fairly held and lawfully conducted, or aids or abets any person in such conduct, is punishable by imprisonment in the County jail for 6 months or imprisonment in the state prison for 16 months or two or three years.


