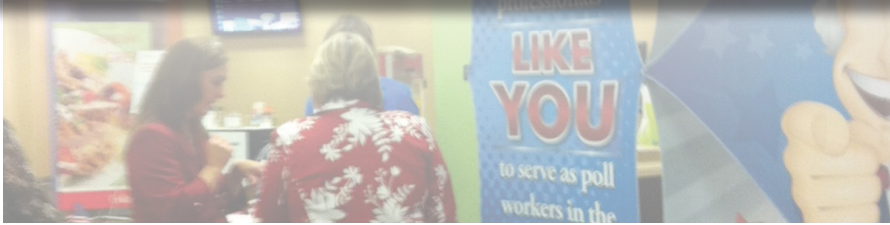


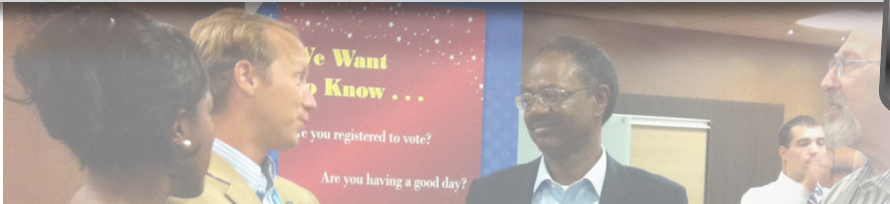
# CHAMPIONS *of Democracy*

Franklin County Board of Elections presents, "Champions of Democracy", a campaign used to recruit employees from local businesses to serve as poll workers on election day. During this process, the Board of Elections:

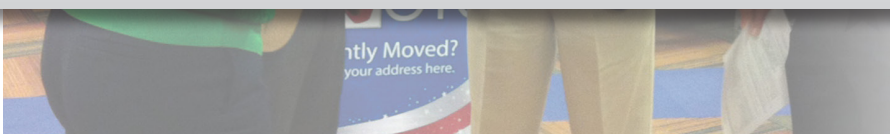
- 1 Dedicates a day to visit the organization, sets up a display to promote Champions of Democracy and helps recruit their associates for the program



- 2 Provides their associates the opportunity to register to vote in the upcoming election.



- 3 Brings a couple of voting machines on that day and, working with the organizations, creates a "mock election" to determine a special event theme, a party menu, or whatever non-political items they would like to 'vote' on.

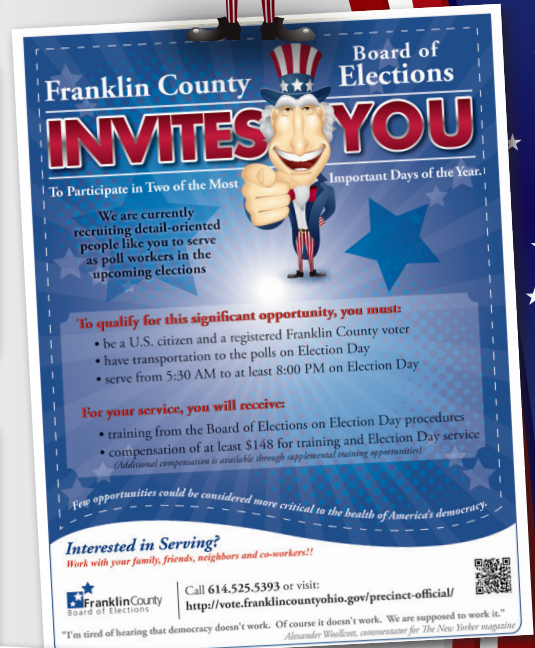
## *Continued:*

**4** Provides the organization with pre-printed posters and flyers to promote Champions of Democracy.

**5** At a later date, holds a training class on site at the organization for their associates to learn election procedures to ensure that they are fully prepared to serve.

**6** The Board of Elections' staff is available to assist them throughout the entire process.

**7** Following the election, each participant is recognized in an ad in The Columbus Dispatch, central Ohio's largest newspaper.
